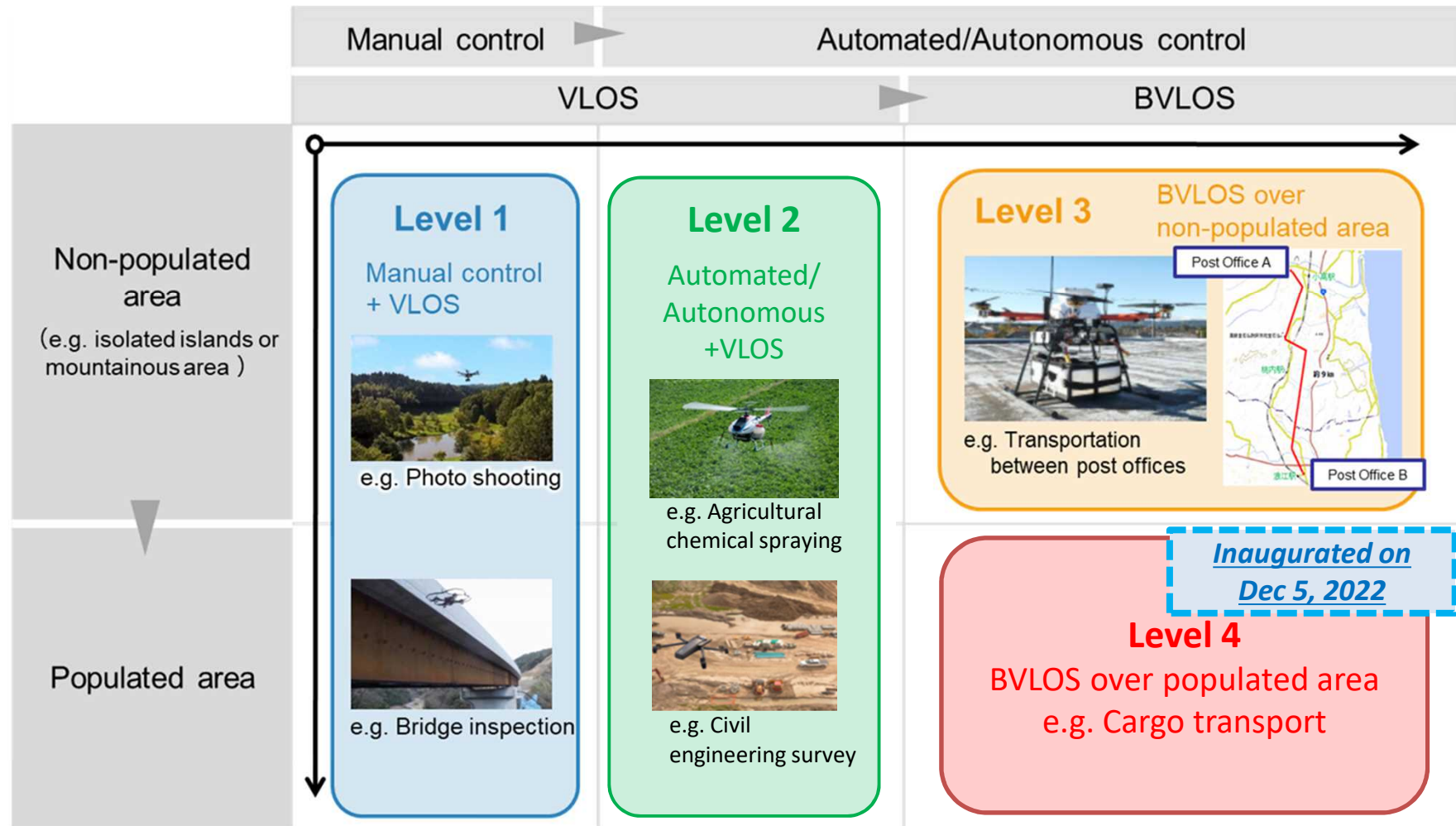


Categories for UAS operation in Japan



UAS Flight Airspace and How to Fly (prescribed by Civil Aeronautics Act)

Flight airspace

Flights are prohibited in airspace A to D.
Restrictions will be lifted if JCAB approval is granted.



* Densely Inhabited Districts (DID) are defined based on census.

How to fly

To be flown in accordance with items 1~8.
Upon JCAB approval, restrictions in items 3~8 will be lifted. (Items 1 and 2 must be followed at all times)

1. No alcohol and drugs 	2. No careless or reckless operation 	3. No night flights 	4. Not beyond visual line of sight 
5. Keep required distance 	6. Not over event sites 	7. No transportation of hazardous materials  <small>Poisonous materials, inflammable liquids, explosives, etc.</small>	8. No dropping objects 

Note: In addition to the above rules, pilots must conduct preflight checks and prevent collisions with aircraft and other UAS.
